the Peace in the County of Clare to be holden at Ennis in
the said County of Clare on the 21st day of October 1889
to have the average price of wheat for the seven years pre-
ceding, inquired of and ascertained in order that such Compo-
sition and such Rent Charge (or so much thereof as may be
subject to variation) may be varied and diminished for
the ensuing seven years in proportion to such average
price and the apportionment thereof varied and diminished
