

and appointed James G. Barry  
of 90 Great Georges Street Limerick  
to be an Arbitrator for ascertaining  
the average price of the barrel of  
good marketable wheat within  
the said County for the term of  
seven years then last past. And  
whereas the said James G. Barry  
ascertained from the Dublin Gazette  
the price of a good barrel of marketable  
wheat upon the said average of  
seven years then preceding to be  
Eighteen Shillings and nine pence  
three farthings and stated and  
set forth same by his Report  
in writing under his hand  
and delivered same to the said  
Justices at the said Sessions.

Now the said Justices do accordingly  
order and adjudge that the  
amount of the said Composition  
for Tithes in the Parish of Kilfenestra  
and the Rent Charge payable in  
lieu thereof shall be diminished  
in proportion to the difference  
between the said average price  
of Eighteen Shillings and nine

pence three farthings per barrel  
for the said period of Seven years  
and the average price as stated  
and set forth in the Certificate  
of Composition and that the  
applotment of said Composition  
shall be amended accordingly  
And it is further ordered that  
each party to this Application  
shall abide his own Costs thereof.
