 in the fourth year of King George the 4th entitled an act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes
 in Ireland for a limited time, do hereby certify that the foregoing agreement and apportionment is a
 faithful impartial and honest one, in the execution of which we have acted to the best of our Skill and
 abilities, and have used and performed the powers and authorities vested and reposed in us as commissioners
 of said parish, which we find to contain three thousand two hundred and twelve acres one rood and
 twenty nine perches English or Statute Measure, which we have divided into six Qualities or Clases as
 underneath, proving all to small fractional part which could not be avoided.

Note in making up the sum to be paid by each individual the fractional
