Fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth intituled
"an act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix atone and Just Com-
position for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the
Parish of Killee in the County of Kerry do hereby Certify that
the Just and true Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is Ninety two pounds by the year of which
Sum of Ninety two pounds, one half is due and payable to the
Earl of Cork as owner of the Rectorial Tithes and one half is
due and payable to the Rev^d Edwin Thomas the vicar of said
Parish.

And we further Certify that the
average price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such
County for the period of Seven years ending on the 1st day of November
1821 is Fifteen Shillings per Bushel.
