

By the Justices assigned to keep the peace
in and for the County of Cork at a General Quarter
Sessions of the peace holden at Bandon and for the
Division of Bandon in Cork County West Riding
on the twenty fourth day of October one thousand eight
hundred and fifty four.

Whereas due notice of application having
been first affixed at the times and in the manner directed by
the Statutes in such case made and provided by The Right
Honourable Richard Earl of Shannon, William Bence Jones
and Sampson Twoood Trench Esquires three Owners of land
in the Parish of Kilgariffe Diocese of Ross Division of Bandon
and Cork County West Riding each charged with the annual
payment of sums exceeding three pounds in respect of the
rentcharges payable in lieu of the Composition for Tithes within
said Parish made by the Certificate of Sancelot Sander
bearing date the twenty eighth day of August one thousand
eight hundred and thirty three and in pursuance of the
statute in such case made and provided And Whereby the
gross amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever in the said
Parish was certified to be the annual sum of four hundred
and thirty pounds the said three Owners of land made
application in Writing to the Justices of the Peace at the
Quarter Sessions above mentioned to have the average price
of wheat being the grain in the Certificate mentioned for the
preceding seven years in the Statutes in that behalf mentioned
enquired of and ascertained in order that the said Composition
for Tithes and the rentcharges in lieu of such Composition might
be diminished according to such average price as compared
with the price of one pound twelve shillings and one half penny
being the price of wheat as set forth in the said Certificate
And Whereas the said applicants and the Vicar of said Parish
having appeared before the said Justices at such Quarter Sessions
by their Counsel and Agents and the said Notice of application
and the average price of wheat as advertised in the Dublin
Gazette for the said period of seven years having been proved
Now the said Justices do ascertain from the said Gazette that
the average price of wheat for the said period of seven years is
