Twenty Stones. And the said Justices do accordingly order
and adjudge that the amount of said Composition for Tithes
in said Parish and the rent charges payable in lieu thereof
shall be diminished in proportion to the difference between
the said average price of one pound seven shillings and two pence
for the said period of seven years and the average price stated
in the said Certificate of Composition and that the apportionment
of such Composition shall be amended accordingly And
the said Justices do further order that the said reduction
shall take effect from the first day of November one thou-
sand eight hundred and fifty four
