

I Launcelot Lander Commissioner duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of the act of Parliament made and now in force for establishing Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilgariffe in the Diocese of ———— Ross, and County of Cork, do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish, is four hundred and thirty pounds by the year, of which Sum of Four hundred and thirty pounds, one half part is due and payable to the Reverend Chamber Corker Townsend as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Vicar of said Parish — and one fourth part is due and payable to Michael Roberts Esquire as one of the Lay Impropriators of said Parish and one other fourth part thereof is due and payable to Thomas Wade Scott Esquire as the other Lay Impropriator of said Parish. And I do further Certify that the average price of Wheat, being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven years ending on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty, is Thirty two Shillings, and one half penny per Tard — Dated this 28th day of August one thousand eight hundred and thirty three —
