

At a meeting of the Special Vestry of the Parish  
of Kildgarry lands on Monday the 29<sup>th</sup> of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1875 held by  
adjournment from Monday the 29<sup>th</sup> of December last, Sir  
John Goddard Bt. chairman - It was resolved that the  
sum of Two hundred & Twenty five pounds sh<sup>l</sup> to be  
paid annually be offered to the Rector the said John  
Chapman as a compensation for the Tithes of the Parish for the  
Space of Twenty years, which sum having been accepted It was  
further resolved that Francis Spring Esq. of Millhouse be elected  
a commissioner on the part of the Curate to act with  
Francis Burt Esq. of Curragh nominated by the Rector as his  
Commissioner for carrying the same into full and due force  
of Law - It was also at the same time resolved that copies  
of this act of Vestry & the signatures thereto be sent by the chair-  
man to the chief Secretary of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese  
and that this Vestry do further adjourn to Thursday the
