whatever within the said Parish, is Two Hundred
and thirty five Pounds by the Year, the entire
of which is due and payable to the Rev John
Murphy as a Composition for the Tithes claim-
able by him as Rector of the said Parish, Dated
this 20 day of August 1825

And we do further Certify that the
average price of oats being the Corn
principally grown in the said
Parish for the period of seven years
ending on the first day of November
1824 is 10-15-2³ per barrel of fourteen
stone
