

Registered on the 19th of December 1833. E. R. Deputy Reg  
I Robert Cross Achmuty Esq. a Commissioner duly appointed a  
Jury under and by Virtue of an Act made in the Second &  
third years of the Reign of his present Majesty King William the 4th  
entituled an Act to amend three Acts passed Respectively in  
the fourth fifth and in the seventh and eight years of the Reign  
of his late Majesty King George the fourth passed for the Establishment  
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions  
permanent. To ascertain & fix a true & just Composition for all  
arising growing yielding or payable within the Parish of Kilglassin  
the County Roscommon and Diocess of Elphin.

Do hereby Certify that the just Composition for all Tithes whatsoever  
within the said Parish is seven Hundred and fifty nine pounds  
nine Shillings and two pence Sterling by the Year of which sum  
seven hundred and fifty nine pounds nine Shillings and two  
pence One half is due and payable to the Reverend Thomas  
Lloyd as a Composition for the Tithe claimed by him as  
vicar of said Parish. and the other one half is due and  
owing to Richard Armstrong Senior Charles Armstrong and  
Richard Armstrong Junior as Lay Impropriators. And I do  
further Certify that the Average price of Oats being the  
Corn principally grown in said Parish for the Period  
of seven years ending the first day of November one  
Thousand Eight Hundred and thirty is twelve Shil-  
lings and Eleven pence halppenny per Barrell.
