I Robert Ormsby having been duly appointed and sworn Commissioner under and by Virtue of an Act made in the 2nd and 3rd year of the Reign of King William the 4th Entituled an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth, and in the seventh and Eighth years of his late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and make such Compositions permanent to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing Yield or payable within the Parish of Killybegs in the County of Sligo do hereby Certify that the true and just Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Four Hundred and seventy two pounds by the year of which sum of Four Hundred and seventy two pounds The One Hundred and Seventeen, Two Hundred and thirty sixths part, equal to Two Hundred and thirty four Pounds is due and payable to the Reverend James Burrows as a Composition for the Tithes claimed by him as Vicar of the said Parish The One Hundred and Seventeen, Two Hundred and thirty sixths part, equal to Two Hundred and thirty four pounds //
