I Robert Ormsby having been duly appointed and sworn Commissioner under and by virtue of an act made in the 2nd and 3rd year of the Reign of King William the 4th Entitled an act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth and in the seventh and eighth Years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the Establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilglasp in the County of Sligo do hereby certify that the true and just composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Four Hundred and Seventy two pounds by the Year of which sum of Four Hundred and Seventy two pounds the One Hundred and Seventeen Two Hundred and thirty sixth part equal to Two Hundred and thirty four Pounds is due and payable to the Rev. James Burrows as a Composition for the tithes claimed by him as Vicar of the said Parish. The one Hundred and Seventeen Two Hundred and thirty sixth part equal to Two Hundred and thirty four Pounds is due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese
