amount of composition for all Tithes whatsover,
within said Parish is Four Hundred & Twenty
Two Pounds & 10 by the year, which sum of
Four Hundred and Twenty Pounds is due & payable
to The Rev. Edw. Jay as Rector of said Parish.

And we do further certify that the average
price of oats being the corn principally grown
for the period of seven years ending the first
day of Novr 1821, was Fifteen Shillings & Sixpence
