

At a Special Vestry of persons qualified according to the act of Parliament of the Fourth Year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth Chap. 99 for the Compositions intituled "an act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" and the several acts made and passed for amending the same, duly convened and held in the Parish Church of the Parish of Kilgobbin on Tuesday the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October 1827. for the purpose of taking into consideration the Certificate of the Commissioners appointed for carrying into execution in said Parish the Provisions of said Acts pursuant to due notice given and published thereof in the said parish Church the two last Sundays the 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> of Oct. Inst. and posted and affixed on the said Parish Church and on the Old Church and Roman Catholic Chapels, in said parish

Resolved that the said Certificate of the Commissioners be and is hereby approved of, and made hereby approved and determined for and on behalf of all the owners and occupiers of land in said parish that the amount of composition mentioned therein one hundred and fifty pounds sterling by the year, shall continue and be unvaried in amount throughout the entire term of twenty one years commencing from the first day of November next, whatever the price of corn may be - Dated this 16<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. 1827 -
