

We John Barnes and Robert Cary Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the Fourth, intituled, 'An Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time; To ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all tithes arising growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilgrant in the County of Tipperary, Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said Parish of Kilgrant is One Hundred and Sixty Three Pounds Sixteen Shillings and Ten pence British of which sum of One Hundred and Sixty Three Pounds Sixteen Shillings and Ten pence the third part are due and payable to the Right Honourable William Bagwell as a composition for the tithes claimable by him as Lay Proprietor: One third part is due and payable to the Reverend Charles Brown as Vicar of the said Parish
