act made in the fourth year of the reign of King  
George the fourth entitled an act to provide for the  
establishing of composition for tithes in Ireland for a  
limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just  
composition for all tithes arising growing yielding and  
payable within the parish of Kilkea in the Co of Widdow  
do hereby certify that the true and just amount for all  
tithes whatever within the said parish is two Hundred  
and Ten Pounds by the year of which sum of two Hundred  
and Ten Pounds two thirds amounting to one Hundred  
and Forty Pounds are due and payable to Sir Walter  
Dixon Burrows Bart. as a composition for the tithes  
claimable by him as owner of the rectorial tithes of the said  
parish and one third amounting to seventy Pounds is due  
and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Archibald Robt Hamilton as Vicar  
of the said parish, and we do further certify that the  
average price of Wheat being the corn principally grown  
in said county for the period of seven years ending the 1<sup>st</sup>  
day of Nov: 1821 one is One Pound Eighteen and eight pence  
per barrel
