sworn, under and by virtue of the acts of Parliament made
and now in force for the establishing, the composition of Tythes
in Ireland, to ascertain and fix a true and just composition
of all tythes, arising, growing yielding or payable, within the Parish
of Kilkennore, in the Diocess of Ross, and county of Cork, Do
hereby certify, that the true and just composition, for all Tythes
whatsoever, within the said Parish of Kilkennore, is five Hundred and
eighty five pounds, six Shillings, and ten pence, of which sum of five
Hundred & eighty five pounds, six Shillings and ten pence, the sum of
Two hundred and sixty two pounds, and two pence is due and payable
to the Rev^d Horace Townsend, as a composition for the Tythes
claimable by him as Vicar of said Parish, and the sum of
one hundred and thirty one pounds, and one penny is due and
payable to Thomas Wade Esq^r as one of the Lay Impropriators
of said Parish, as a composition for the Tythes claimable by him
as such Lay Impropriator, and the sum of One Hundred and thirty
one pounds and one penny is due and payable to Michael Roberts
Esq^r, the other Lay Impropriator of said Parish, as a composition for
the tythes claimable by the said Michael Roberts, as such Lay
Impropriator, and the sum of sixty one pounds six shillings and
five pence is due & payable to the Dean and chapter of Ross
as a composition for the tythes claimable by the said Dean
and chapter of Ross, in said Parish, and I do further certify
