 Townsend as a Composition for the Tithes claimable  
 by him as Vicar of said Parish and the other sum  
 15 of £131 and one penny is due and payable to the  
 Wm Fote Esq as one of the Lay Impropriators of  
 said Parish as a Composition for the Tithes claimable  
 by him as such Lay Impropriator and the sum of  
 £131 and one penny is due and payable to Michael  
 20 Roberts Esq the other Lay Impropriator of said Parish  
 as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by the  
 said Michael Roberts as such Lay Impropriator and  
 the sum of £61. 6. 5 is due and payable to  
 the Dean and Chapter of Ross as a Composition  
 25 for the Tithes claimable by the said Dean and  
 Chapter of Ross in said Parish and I do  
 further certify that the average price of wheat  
 being the corn principally grown in said  
 County for seven years preceding 1<sup>st</sup> Oct 1830  
 is one pound and twelve shillings and  
 30 three half pence per barrell.
