due and payable to the Reverend John Dennis
as a Composition for Tithes Claimable by him
as Rector of said parish -

and he further Certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown
in such County for the period of seven years
ending on the 21st day of November 1792
is £. 15. 2½ per Barrel
