

We Josiah Crampton and Cecil Crampton Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act
made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George
the fourth intituled an Act to provide for the estab-
lishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a
limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just
composition for all tithes arising growing yielded or
payable within the Parish of Kilkenny in the
County of Galway, do hereby certify that the true
and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is One hundred and twenty
two pounds two shillings and ten pence halfpenny
by the year. The whole of which Sum is due and
payable to the Rev^d John Meara as a Composition
for the Tithe claimable by him as Rector and Vicar
of the said Parish.

And We do further certify that the average Price
of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in
such County, for the Period of seven years ending
on the first day of November one thousand eight
hundred and twenty one is Thirty eight shillings
and eight pence halfpenny per Bachel.

And We do further certify that We have increased
the Amount of such Composition beyond the average
Amount of such Tithes during seven years preceding
the first day of November one thousand eight hundred
and twenty one, by adding to the said average
Amount the sum of Four pounds two shillings and
eleven pence, in consequence of Losses sustained by
Neglect or Mismanagement in the year One thousand
eight hundred and sixteen.
