Thomas Spring, Commissioner appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the second and third year of the reign of his Majesty King William the fourth entitled an act to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth and in the seventh and eight year of the reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of impositions for tithes in Ireland and to make such impositions permanent do ascertain and fix a true and just imposition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the parish of Hillcarrigan in the County of Cork - do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said parish is two hundred pounds Sterling, and is due and payable to Edward Duxley, Esq. as a composition for the tithes claimable by him as lessee of the Lay Impropriator, and I do further certify that the average price of Oats, being the corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven years, ending the first day of November 1830 is 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> per Barrel -
