certify that the true and just amount of
Composition for all tithes whatever within the
Said parish is four hundred and fifty pounds
by the year of which sum of four hundred and
fifty pounds Two third parts thereof are due and
payable to Bindon Scott as a Composition for the
Tithes claimable by him as lay impropriator
of the said parish and one third part thereof
