

We John Murta and Richard Ryan commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of
an act made in the fourth year of the reign of
King George the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to
provide for the establishing of compositions for
tithes in Ireland for a limited time: to ascer-
tain and fix a true and just composition
for all tithes arising, growing, yielded, or pay-
able within the Parish of Killagh and of County
of Westmeath, do hereby certify, that the true
and just amount of composition for all tithes
whatsoever within the said parish is forty pounds
by the year - of which sum of forty pounds the
whole is due and payable to the Reverend Michael
De Courcy D. D. as a composition for the tithes
claimable by him as Rector of the said parish.

And we do further certify, that the average
price of oats, being the corn principally grown
in such county, for the period of seven years,
ending on the first day of November 1821, is fifteen
shilling and two pence farthing per barrel
dated this 7th day of October 1831.
