

We Stephen J Donelan of Killagh and John Alman of Eyrecourt Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the 11th year of the reign of King George the fourth "entituled an act to provide for the establishing of compositions for Tythes in Ireland for a limited time and an act to amend the same" to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tythes arising, growing, yielded & payable within the parish of Killallerton in the County of Galway, do hereby certify that the true and just amount of compositions for all whatever within the said parish is one hundred and eighty five pounds of the present British currency by the year of which sum of One hundred and eighty five pounds sterling one hundred and fifty pounds sterling of the present British currency is due and payable to the Reverend Vincent and his successors as a composition of the tythes claimable by him as Rector of the said parish and Twenty five pounds sterling is due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Clonfert and his successors in the period of twenty five years And we do further certify that the average price of oats being the corn principally grown in such county for the period of years ending on the 31st day of November One thousand eight hundred and twenty one is ten shillings and six pence per barrel Dated this 26 day of October 1826 Six
