Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth "Entituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland for a limited time, and an Act to amend the same" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tythes arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Killalton in the County of Galway do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Compositions for all Tythes whatsoever within the said parish is one Hundred and Eighty pound Sterling - of the present British Currency by the year of which sum of One hundred and Eighty pounds Sterling of the present Currency one hundred and forty five pound Sterling of the present British Currency is due and payable to the Reverend Vincent and his Successors as a Composition of the Tythes claimable by him as Rector of the said parish, and Thirty five pound Sterling of the present British Currency is due and payable to the Bishop of the Diocese of Clonsilla and his Successors for the period of Twenty one years  
And we do further Certify that the average price of oats being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred and twenty one is Ten Shillings per Barrel
