certify, that the true and just amount of Composition
for the Vicarial Tithes within the said Parish is
Forty five pounds, sterling by the year, being the sum
agreed upon under the Twenty seventh Section of this

than seven Vestry Men duly qualified to vote at the
said Vestry - and from every information we can
collect, the said Forty five pounds are not below
the average of the seven years prescribed by the
act. and the said Forty five pounds are due &
payable to the Rev. Anthony, Thomas, as a
