Trustees and Commissioners in their actual possession nor being by virtue of a bargain and sale  
by Hugh Mc Lornian in consideration of the sum of five hundred pounds for the term of one whole year by  
virtue of the said Statute for transferring lands into possession and to their heirs  
of the Impropriate Rectory or Rectories of the said Tythes of the said two Parishes of Killybeg and Killy-  
murry and all the estate right title equity of Redemption claim and demand of them  
the said Tythes of the said two Parishes of Killybeg and Killymurry or any part thereof
