

We John Lucas and Simon O'Donnell Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the Fourth intituled "An Act to provide for the establishing of a composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time" and also an Act made in the Fifth year of the reign of the said King intituled "An Act to amend the same" to ascertain and fix a just and true composition for all tithes arising growing yearly or payable within the Parish of Shullard in the County of Clare do hereby certify that as a Vestry duly assembled at Dunbeg in the said Parish of Shullard on the Twentieth day of January One thousand Eight Hundred and twenty five for the purpose of carrying into execution the purposes of the said Acts that Mr Anthony Nolan on the part of the Right Honorable Lord Castlecoote and Mr James Macpoodle on the part of Richard Macpoodle Esq were then and there enter into an Agreement with the Chairman and members of the Vestry so assembled that a sum in proportion to the sum to be paid to the Reverend Swine Whitty for the vicarial tithes of the said Parish shall be annually paid for their the Lord Castlecootes & Richd Macpoodles part of the Tithes of the said Parish of Shullard being the Lay Impropriate

ate tithes of certain Howlands of said Parish which we consider a just and fair composition for their parts of the tithes of the said Parish and that the said composition shall remain in full force and effect for the whole space of twenty one years and shall not be subject to variation in the amount thereof during such period of twenty one years whatsoever the price of corn may be and we further certify that on one appraisement of the sum of One Hundred and ten pounds the composition entered into with the said Rev Swine Whitty Incumbent of said Parish of Shullard find the Proportion arising to the said Lord Castlecoote out of the Howlands of Dunmore Shullard Habirlean Balarad Lisorney Phiscurren and Inough in said Parish amounts to the sum of eighty five pounds fourteen Shillings and two pence appear and the proportion arising to Richd Macpoodle Esq out of the Howland of Glapeloone in said Parish amounts to the sum of Thirteen Pounds Four Shillings and seven pence appear making in the whole Two Hundred and eight pounds eighteen Shillings & seven pence appear
