said Parish of Killead being the Improprate lay Tithes of
certain Ploughlands of said Parish which we consider a just
and fair composition for their parts of the Tithes of the
said Parish and that the said composition shall remain in full
force and effect for the whole space of Twenty one years and
shall not be subject to any variation in the amount
thereof during such period of Twenty one years whatever
the price of Corn may be, and We further certify that on
due application of the sum of One Hundred and Ten pounds the
composition entered into with the said Rev^d Rowie Whitty
Incumbent of said Parish of Killead we find the proportion
arising to the said Lord Castlecote out of the Ploughlands of
Dunmore Killead and Cahinlean, Baland Lisnuse and
Liscurren and Enogh in said Parish amounts to the sum of
Eighty five pounds fourteen shillings and two pence a year,
and the proportion arising to Rich^d Macpooles out of
the Plough land of Glasscloone in said Parish amounts to
the sum of Thirteen pounds four shillings and seven
pence a year, making in the whole Two Hundred
and

and Eight pounds Eighteen Shillings and nine pence a year.
