

Certificate of the Tithe Composition apploled
on Certain Townlands in the Parish of Killare
Diocese of Meath. Barony of Rathconrath and
County of Westmeath.

J. James Jocelyn Poë of Riverston in the County
of Tipperary Esquire, Commissioner duly appointed
and sworn, under and by Virtue of an Act, made
in the 2^d and 3^d years of the reign of King William
the 4th intituled "an act to amend three acts
" passed respectively in the 4th and 5th and in the
" 7th and 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty
" King George the 4th providing for the establishing
" of Composition for Tithes in Ireland, and to make
" such Composition permanent;" and of an Act passed in
the 2^d year of the reign of her present Majesty, intituled
"An Act to authorise the immediate distribution of
" a portion of the Fund applicable to the relief of persons
" entitled to Certain arrears of Tithe Composition,
" under an Act of the last Session, of Parliament
" to abolish Composition for Tithes in Ireland. and
