By the Lord Lieutenant General and General Governor of Ireland.

CARLISLE.

Whereas by an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd years of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the 4th entitled an Act to Amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th., 5th., and in the 7th., & 8th. years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the 4th providing for the establishment of composition for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent. It is amongst other things enacted that in and for every Parish or parts of a Parish in Ireland wherein a Composition for Tithes thereof shall not have been made under the said Acts with the several persons entitled to Tithes therein within three months after ^{the} passing of the said Acts it shall and may be lawful for the Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or Governors of Ireland when and as he or they shall so think fit to nominate some person to be a Commissioner for carrying the said Act of the 2nd and 3rd years of King William the 4th and the Acts therein recited into execution within such Parish.

And Whereas by an Act passed in the 1st and 2nd years of the Reign of Her present Majesty entitled an Act to abolish Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to substitute Rent Charges in lieu thereof it is amongst other things enacted that the right of all persons in and of all Tithes or compositions for Tithes ^{to} therefore accrued or at any time theretofore to accrue due in Ireland shall wholly cease and be determined.

And Whereas by an Act passed in the 2nd year of the Reign of Her present Majesty entitled "An Act to authorize the immediate distribution of a portion of the fund applicable to the relief of persons entitled to certain arrears of Tithe Compositions
