true and just amount of composition for  
such portion or <sup>part of</sup> one half Tithes <sup>whatsoever</sup>  
within the said separate and distinct  
part or portion of the said Parish called  
The five Plough Lands, is Seventy Pounds  
ten shillings Sterling by the year which Seventy  
Pounds ten shillings Sterling is due and  
payable to The Rev<sup>d</sup> George Bishopp as  
a composition for the Tithes claimable by  
him as Archdeacon of Aghadoe, And  
we do further Certify that the average price  
of Oats being the corn principally grown  
in such County for the period of seven  
years ending on the first day of November  
one thousand eight hundred and twenty one  
is fifteen shillings and five pence farthing
