in the County of Kerry, do Certify that the true  
and just amount of Composition for such portion  
or one half part of All tithes whatsoever within  
the said Parish is Five hundred and Sixty Pounds  
Sterling by the year, Which sum of Five hundred  
and Sixty pounds is due and payable to The  
Reverend John Agley as composition for  
the Tithes claimable by him as Vicar of the said  
Parish, And we do further Certify that  
the average price of Oats being the Corn prin-  
cipally grown in such County, for the period  
of seven years ending on the first day of  
November One thousand eight hundred and  
twenty one, is fifteen shillings and two pence  
farthing for Barrel,
