Commissioners duly appointed and sworn
under and by virtue of an Act or Acts made
in the fourth and fifth years of the Reign of King
George the fourth. providing for the Establishing
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a
limited time, to ascertain and fix a true
and just Composition for a Portion of All Tithes
arising, growing, yielding, or payable to The
Vicar of Killybeg within the Parish of Killybeg
in the County of Kerry, do Certify that the true
and just Amount of Composition for such Portion
or one half part of All Tithes whatever within
the said Parish is Two hundred and Sixty Pounds
Sterling by the year, which Sum of Two hundred
and Sixty Pounds is due and payable to The Reverend
Arthur Hyde as Composition for the Tithes claim-
able by him as Vicar of the said Parish.
And we do further Certify that the Average Price
of Oats being the Corn principally grown in such
County, for the Period of Seven years ending on
the first day of November One thousand eight
hundred and twenty one is Fifteen shillings and
two pence farthing for Barrel.

At a special Vestry held for the purpose of taking
the above Certificate into consideration it was
Resolved and unanimously agreed to that such Composition
shall be invariable for the Term of twenty one years
from the first day of May One thousand eight hundred
and twenty five, and that such Composition shall
