or to James J. Pawlor of Killarney in the County of Kerry  
Esq. as his Deputee thereof - And I further Certify  
that the average price of Oats being the Corn principally  
grown in said Parish for the period of Ten years  
ending on the first day of November, One Thousand eight  
hundred and thirty, is twelve Shillings and Eleven  
Pence half penny Sterling per Barrel
