We Anthony Blackburn and Philip Pendleton Esqrs Commissioners, duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of reign of King George the fourth intituled "An Act to provide for the establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" do ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Killeary in the County of Meath do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is three hundred and fifty Pounds by the year, of which Sum of three hundred and fifty Pounds, twelve thirty fifth parts are due and payable to the Rev^d Baron William Disney as a composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Vicar of the said Parish and twenty three thirty fifth parts are due and payable to the Rev^d W. Gregory as Rector of the said Parish. And we do further certify that the above twelve thirty fifth parts amount to the Sum of One hundred and twenty pounds and that the aforesaid twenty three thirty fifth parts amount to the Sum of two hundred and thirty pounds.

And we do further certify that the average price of Oats, being the corn principally grown in such county for the period of Seven years ending the first day of November 1821 is fifteen shillings and two pence halfpenny per Barrel
