

We the Rev. James Slator and James Cluxton, Commissioners duly appointed and sworn, under and by virtue of an Act made in the fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, entitled, An Act to provide for the establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding or payable within the Parish of Killishee in the County of Kildare, do hereby Certify, that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two hundred and thirty two pounds, thirteen shillings by the year, due and payable to the Rev. Arthur McGuire as a composition for the Tithe claimable by him, as Rector of said Parish. And we do further Certify, that the average price of wheat, being the Corn principally growing in said County for the period of seven years, ending on the thirty first day of October 1821, is £1.10.0 per Barrell, and the average price of Oats, growing in said County for the period of seven years ending on the 31. day of October 1821, is £0.10.0 per Barrell, dated at Naas this 25th day of April 1825.

I Walter H. Mansfield, do swear, that I will faithfully, honestly and impartially, according to the best of my skill and ability, execute and perform the Powers and Authorities reposed in me as umpire, by virtue of an Act passed in the fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, entitled An Act to provide for establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, in the Parish of Killishee, according to the directions of the said Act, and according to Equity and good conscience and without partiality, Favour or Affection, prejudice or Malice, to any person or persons whomsoever; And that I am not owner or Proprietor of any Tithes, nor Owner nor Occupier of any Lands subject to the Payment of any Tithes or Composition for Tithes, in the said Parish of Killishee, nor Agent or Steward of any person so interested.
