

I Walter H. Mansfield Esq. having  
been duly appointed and sworn an Umpire, under  
and by virtue of An Act, made in the Fourth year of  
the Reign of King George the Fourth, entitled, An Act to  
provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in  
Ireland for a limited time, ascertain and fix a true and  
just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding  
or payable within the Parish of Kilkishee in the County  
of Kildare, do hereby Certify, that the true and just  
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever, within  
the said Parish is Two hundred and Thirty two pounds  
Thirteen Shillings by the year, which sum is due and  
payable to the Rev. Arthur McGuire as a Composition  
for the Tithe claimable by him as Rector of the said  
Parish.

And I do further Certify, that the average  
price of Wheat, being the Corn principally grown  
in said County for the period of seven years, ending  
on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of October 1821, is One pound, eighteen  
Shillings and eight pence half penny per Barrel,

Dated at Naas this 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1825.
