

I, *James West O'Brien*

(having been duly appointed and sworn a Commissioner under, and by virtue of, an Act made in the Second and Third years of the Reign of King WILLIAM IV. intituled—"An Act to amend Three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King GEO. IV., providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent"—to Ascertain and Fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of *Kellashree in the* Diocese of *Armagh* in the County of *Longford*)

DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the True and Just amount of Composition for all Tithes, whatever, within the said Parish of *Kellashree* as ascertained from the Seven Years Average preceding the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirty is *One Hundred and Eighty three pounds Seven Shillings and Eight pence, Sixty* by the Year, of which Sum of *One Hundred and Eighty three pounds Seven Shillings and Eight pence, the Sum of One Hundred and Forty Eight* pounds Nine Shillings and two pence

is due and payable to *The Reverend William Digby* as a Composition for all Tithes claimable by him as *Rector and Vicar* of said Parish, and the Sign of *Thirty four pounds Seventeen Shillings and Ten pence* Shillings and

is due and payable to *his Grace the Arch Bishop* as *Bishop* of said Diocese from and out of the Townlands of *Bernacly, Ballinacilly, Ballinamona, Cloonagh, Clontibock, Clontala, Clontree, Derragone, Killeeney, Middlebrook, and Rapperyhill* out of which Townlands his Grace is entitled to two thirds of the Tithes of Crops Only—

And I do further Certify, that the average price of Oats—being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven Years, ending the First Day of November One thousand eight hundred and thirty—is *Twelve Shillings and Eleven pence* halfpenny British per Quarter
