

A William Davin Commissioner duly appointed, and  
Sworn under, and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year  
of the reign of King George the 4<sup>th</sup>, intituled an act to provide  
for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland  
and also an act passed in the second and third years  
of the Reign of William the Fourth, intituled an act to  
Amend three acts passed respectively, in the fourth, fifth  
and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of His  
late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the ~~consti-~~  
~~tution~~ establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland  
And to make such compositions permanent, and fix  
a true and just composition for all Tythes, arising  
growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Kill  
nasnet in the County of Litchim, Do hereby certify  
that the true and just amount of Compositions for all  
Tythes whatever within the said Parish of Killnasnet  
is Two Hundred and five Pounds by the year  
being the sum agreed upon by the said Bishop of  
Kilmore, The Rev<sup>d</sup> Abraham Hamblin the incumbent  
and a special Vestry held in the Parish Church of  
the Union of Manokhamilton, of which Barney Cross  
Cullen Esq of Glenade was Chairman, of which sum  
two third parts are due and payable to The Lord  
Bishop of Kilmore, as the composition of the Tythes  
claimable by him, as owner of the Rectorial  
Tythes, and that the remaining portion or  
one third is due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Ab-  
raham Hamblin as owner of the Vicarial  
Tythes of said Parish
