

Amount of Composition for the Tithes of the Parish of
Killaspickbrone being a part of the perpetual Union
of Saint John in the Diocese of Elphin in the County of Ligo
as ascertained by Arthur Drwin and Robert Dickson Com^{rs}
appointed by Virtue of an Act 4th George IV and the same being
payable to the Rev^d Charles Hamelton as Rector and Vicar of
said Parish as a Composition for the Tithes Claimable by him
from the lands of said Parish amounting to the sum of Two
Hundred pounds Ten Shillings & Three pence Sterling
by the year. The average price of Oats as taken from the
Dublin Gazette for the seven years ending the 1st November 1821
being Fifteen Shillings and two pence farthing $\frac{1}{4}$ per Bushel of 14 Stone
We have by the annexed appointment for the said
Composition of £200:10:3 ascertained and fixed that the Number
of one twentieth of Tithable Acres are 77004⁶/₃₂ and that the sum
of 15s 2p farthing for each one twentieth in quality is the just
and equitable sum to be distributed on said portions, which is
to be levied and raised according to this appointment, in which
the sum to be paid by each person is put down in figures &
written in words in line with their respective Names and
Lands, Given under our hands by the powers Vested
In Us
