



In the Matter of an Application to vary Tithe Rent Charge of the Parish of Killea in the Diocese of Waterford in the County of Waterford.

Whereas it appearing to the Chairman and Justices presiding at the Quarter Sessions of the Peace for the County of Waterford held at Waterford on the twenty fourth day of September One thousand eight hundred and eighty nine that the Right Honorable Robert Shapland George Julian Lord Baron Cairw, the Right Honorable Hugh Earl Fortescue and the Right Honorable Mary Anne Grace Louisa Viscountess Doneraile being three land holders in the Parish of Killea in the Diocese of Waterford in the County of Waterford, each of whom is respectively liable to and charged with the annual payment of the sum of three pounds or upwards for Rent Charge in lieu of Composition for Tithes within the said Parish (other than Tithe Rent Charge which became vested in the Commissioners of Church Temporalities in Ireland under or by virtue of the Irish Church Act 1869 or the Acts Amending the same) caused a Notice in writing signed by them to be posted on the principal outer doors of the Church of said Parish and of every other known place of religious Worship in such Parish on two successive Sundays since the first day of May One thousand eight hundred and eighty nine, that is to say on Sunday the first day of September One thousand eight hundred and eighty nine and on Sunday the Eighth day of September One thousand eight hundred and eighty nine pursuant to the Statute in that case made and provided, the last of such Sundays being more than
