

Gilbert under his hand delivered to the Justices at said Sessions that the average price of good marketable Oats for the last Seven years was Eleven shillings and ten pence Sterling per barrel according to the returns published in the Dublin Gazette. And it appearing that the Rent Charge payable in lieu of the Composition for the said Improprate Tithes was the sum of One hundred and ten pounds fifteen shillings and four pence half penny being three fourths of the said sum of One hundred and forty seven pounds thirteen shillings and ten pence, and upon hearing the evidence given before the said Justices in open Court. It is Ordered by the said Justices that the said sum of One hundred and forty seven pounds thirteen shillings and ten pence being the Composition mentioned in said Certificate as claimable by the said James Aylward or his said Lessee, be diminished by a sum of Twenty three pounds and ten pence farthing Sterling and that the same shall be One hundred and twenty four pounds twelve shillings and eleven pence three farthings annually and that pursuant to the Statute of 1 and 2 Victoria, Chapter 109 the Rent Charge in lieu of Composition so far as same is payable to the said James Aylward or those deriving under him shall be three fourths of the said Composition of One hundred and twenty four pounds twelve shillings and eleven pence three farthings that is to say; - a sum of Ninety three pounds Nine shillings and Nine pence annually to be paid and payable to the parties entitled and that the same shall commence and be payable from the first day of May One thousand eight hundred and ninety. And it is further Ordered that the Assessment and Applotment of the said Composition shall be amended accordingly. And that the applotment



of the Tithe Rent Charge payable in lieu of the said Composition for the Improprate Tithe of the said Parish be reduced and diminished in like proportion. Dated at Waterford in the Division and County of Waterford this twenty fourth day of September One thousand eight hundred and eighty nine.
