of the reign of King George the fourth entitled a  
Act for the Establishment of composition for tithes  
in Ireland to ascertain and fix a true and  
just composition of <sup>the</sup> tithes arising growing  
yielded or Payable within the Parish of  
Killeagh in the County of Cork, do hereby certify that  
the true & just composition for all tithes ~~whatsoever~~  
due with the said Parish is ~~three hundred and~~  
~~seventy four Pounds ten Shillings and six Pence~~  
by the year and that the said sum is due and  
Payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Dr. Arch<sup>d</sup> Henry Rogers Rector  
of the aforesaid Parish of Killeagh and I  
do further certify that the average price  
of Wheat being the principal corn grown  
in this County for the Period of seven years  
ending my first day of November 1830 is  
one Pound twelve Shillings and one half penny  
per barrel given and my hand this  
13<sup>th</sup> December 1833 W. Jones to the
