

I William Jones a Commissioner duly sworn under & by
virtue of an Act passed in the 2^d & 3^d years of the reign of King
William the fourth, entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed
respectively in the 4th, 5th & 8th years of the reign of his late
Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing
Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions
permanent. — To ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable, with the Parish
of Killeagh in the County of Lark, do hereby certify, that the
true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever
within the said Parish is nine Hundred and seventy four
Pounds ten Shillings & six pence, and that the said sum of nine
Hundred & seventy four Pounds ten Shillings & six pence is due
and payable to the Rev. Doctor Rich^d Henry Rogers as Rector
of said Parish of Killeagh, as a Composition for all Tithes
claimable by him out of said Parish, and I do further certify
that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally
grown in that County during the period of seven years
ending the first of November 1830 thirty is one Pound twelve
shillings & one half penny per Barrel. — given under
my hand this 13th day of December
