Whereas due notice of application having been first  
affixed at the times and in the manner directed by the  
statutes in such case made and provided by John  
Courtenay, Henry Pratt and Richard Tonson Esquires  
three persons owners of land in the Parish of Killeagh  
Diocese of Cloyne Division of Middleton and Cork County  
East Riding each charged with the annual payment of  
the sum of three pounds and upwards in respect of the  
rent charge payable in lieu of the composition for tithes  
within said parish made by the certificate of William  
Jones bearing date thirteenth day of December One thousand  
Eight hundred and thirty three and in pursuance of the statute  
in such case made and provided and Whereby the gross  
amount of composition for all tithes whatever in the said  
parish was certified to be the Annual sum of Eight hundred  
and fifty pounds the said three Owners of Land made application  
in writing to the Justices of the Peace at the Quarter Sessions  
above mentioned to have the average price of wheat being  
the Grain in the Certificate mentioned for the preceding
