Kilbragh in the county of Meath, do hereby certify that the  
true & just <sup>amount of</sup> composition for all tithes, whatever within  
the said parish is two hundred & twenty pounds by the  
year due & payable to the Rev. & Rich. B. Vincent as a com-  
position for the tithes claimable by him as rector of the  
said parish - And we do further certify that the average  
price of oats according to the official return from the  
Dublin Gazette, being the corn principally grown in  
said county, for the period of seven years ending on the  
1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1821 is fifteen shillings and  
two pence nothing per barrel - Signed
