George the fourth Intitled an Act to provide for the estab-  
-lishing of composition for tythes in Ireland for a limited  
time to Ascertain and fix a true and Just composition  
for all tythes arising growing yielded or payable within the  
Parish of Killeenaduma in the County of Galway, do  
hereby Certify that the true and Just amount of composition  
for all tythes Whatever within the Said Parish is One Hundred  
and Sixty Six Pounds fourteen Shillings and one Penny by the  
Year, of which Sum One Hundred and fifty two Pounds -  
fourteen Shillings & one Penny are due and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Denis  
Brown as a composition for the tythes claimable by him as  
Rector of the Said Parish, and fourteen Pounds is due and  
payable to the Very Rev<sup>d</sup> Dean Hawkins as Dean of Clonsfert  
And we do further Certify that the Average Price of wheat  
being the Corn principally grown in Such County for the  
Period of Seven years ending on the thirty first day  
of October 1821 is One Pound eighteen Shillings and  
eight Pence half Penny per Barrel Given Under our  
Hands and Seals the 17 day of Septem<sup>r</sup> 1825
