Ireland for a limited time to Ascertain and fix a true
and Just Composition for all tythes arising growing
Yielded or payable within the Parish of Killeenadumma
in the County of Galway, do hereby Certify that
the true and Just Amount of Compositions for all tythes
Whatever within the Said Parish is One hundred and
Sixty Six Pounds fourteen Shillings and one Penny ^{by the year}
of which Sum one hundred and fifty two Pounds
fourteen Shillings and one Penny are due and
payable to the Rev Denis Brown as a composition
for the tythe claimable by him as Rector of the Said
Parish and fourteen Pounds is due and payable
to the Very Rev Deane Hawkins as Dean of Clonfert
And we do further Certify that the average price of
wheat being the corn principally grown in such
County for the period of seven years ending on the thirty
first day of Oct^r 1821 is one Pound eighteen Shill^{ings} and
eight Pence half penny per Bush ^{given under our hands}
the 17 Septem^r 1825
