an Act to provide for the Establishing of composition
for tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain
and fix a true and just composition for all tithes
arising growing yielded or payable within the
Parish of Killeen aduna in the County of Galway
do hereby Certify that the true and just amount
of compositions for all tithes whatever within the
Said Parish is One hundred and Sixty Six Pounds
fourteen Shillings and one Penny by the Year, of
which Sum, One hundred and fifty two Pounds
fourteen Shillings and one Penny are due and
payable to the Rev^d Denis Brown as a composition
for the tithes claimable by him as Rector of the Said
Parish and fourteen Pounds is due & payable to
the Very Rev^d James Haughton as Dean of Confert and
we do further Certify that the Average Price of wheat
being the Corn principally grown in such County for
the Period of Seven years ending on the thirty first day of
October 1821 is One Pound eighteen Shillings and eight pence
half Penny & Barrel Given Under our hands
and Seals the 17th day of September 1825
